Page Titles


- Descriptive and concise
- So many pages titled "Research" across campus

Headings

- Meaningful and descriptive
- Structured (don't jump from <h2> to <h6> because you like the look




Readability

- Reduce copy to only what is necessary to convey the information
- Break up content with headings, lists, and white space
- Use Hemingway App: hemingwayapp.com

Calls to Action

 Ex: academic program pages - allow user time to learn about the program and place the button to apply lower down on the page

Findability

 Meta descriptions, page titles, intuitive language, relevant content





Q: Will the training material be available afterwards for future reference?

Q: When will video tutorials be available for users?

A: Our plan has always been to enhance our self-help resources with a design library and video tutorials. Now that the design library has been rolled out, we are excited to announce that we will start rolling out video tutorials within the next couple of months.

QUESTIONS

Q: Best methods to overwrite/update existing PDFs on website to reflect immediate change in real time.

A: To address caching issues that may retain old versions of files, there's a useful trick available, provided you are using a link from your website to access the PDF file. Simply modify the URL of the link by adding a question mark and some text to the end of the URL.

For example:

Original URL: https://websites.it.utah.edu/files/my_pdf_file.pdf

Modified URL:

https://websites.it.utah.edu/files/my_pdf_file.pdf?version1

This slight modification prompts the user's browser to treat it as a new file, fetching the updated version from the server instead of using the cached one. Importantly, this alteration does not impact any other aspects of loading the file.

QUESTIONS

Q: Is there a way to integrate Omni pages with a Collibra database?

A: Certainly! If the database is accessible with PHP, the integration is very simple. Feel free to contact us, and we'll be happy to assist you in getting set up.

Q: Anyone else experiencing a "space" character bug after inserting a hyperlink on a webpage?

A: While our team has not heard any reports of spacing issues with hyperlinks, the WYSIWYG does occasionally add extra and
br> tags. This can be removed by going into the inline source code, locating the unnecessary tag and deleting it.
